
Never Seek to Tell Thy Love: A Love Odyssey



Andrew Oerke has wandered over the entire globe. His eye is shrewd, his mind capacious, and his generosity toward humankind is endless. His poems, whether set in Africa, Mexico, or in the United States, invariably offer fresh perspectives upon the reality he has encountered. I particularly am moved by his Mexican sequence, where an elegiac intensity permeates his work. Though his subjectivity is admirably realized, he refreshes the reader with an achieved singularity. His is a singularity that cares both for itself and for others, unlike certain other poets who attain their individualities by being indifferent both to the self and to others. Oerkes voice has matured into one that is very much his own. He has absorbed and transformed the influence of his former teacher, the admirable American poet Mark Strand. When I consider that Oerke is very much a person who lives out in the world, actively restoring the ecological balance of the oceans, and aiding other men and women to live better lives, I am profoundly moved that he should also have his sustained ability to enter, again and again, the universe of reverie and of quiet contemplation.
