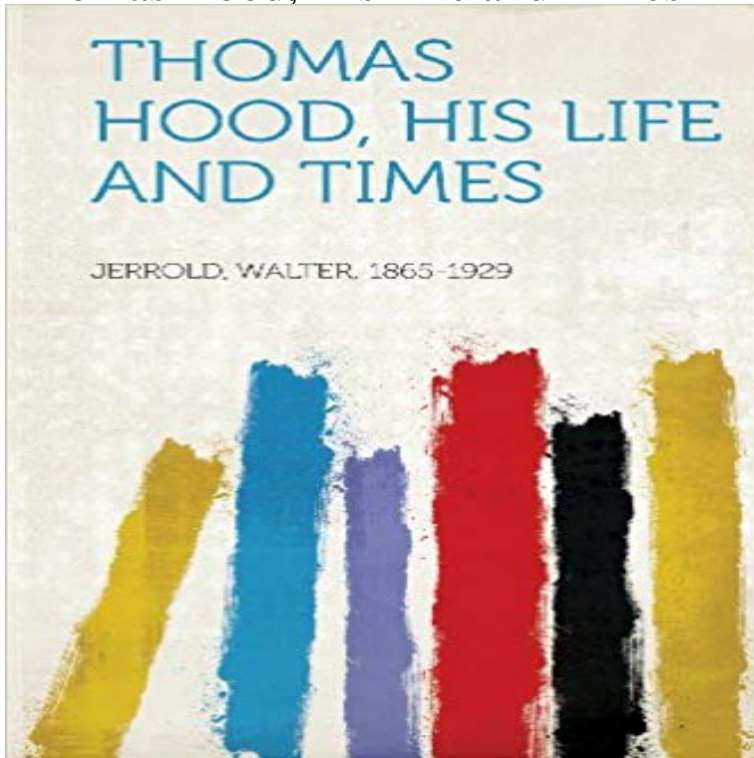


Thomas Hood, His Life and Times
