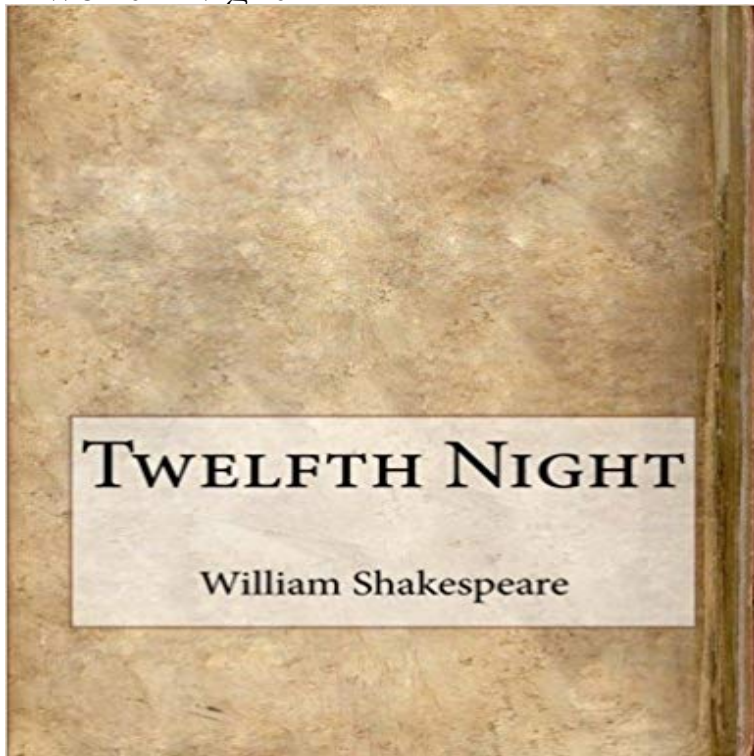


# Twelfth Night

The main title is believed to be an afterthought, created after John Marston premiered a play titled What You Will during the course of the writing.
