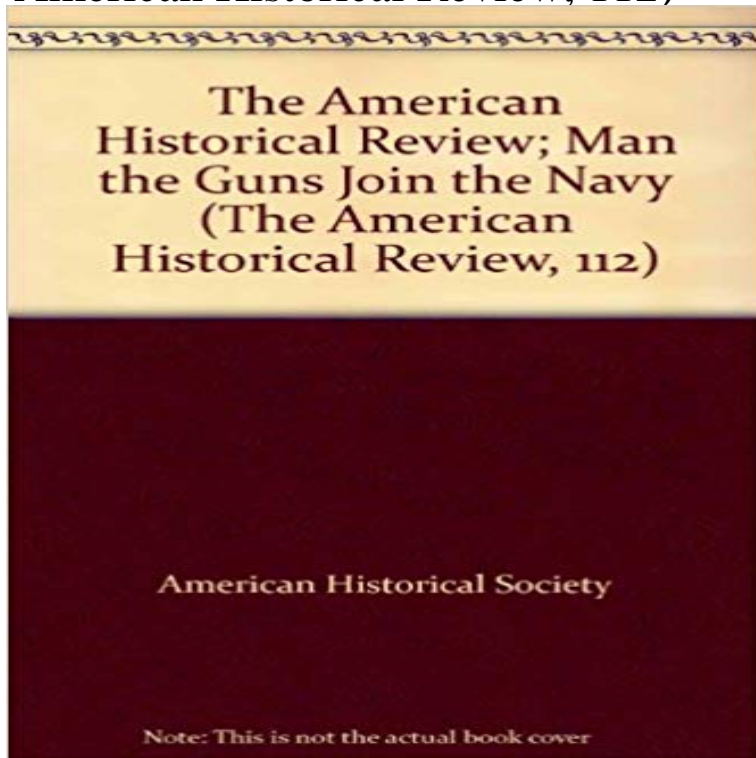


The American Historical Review; Man the Guns Join the Navy (The American Historical Review, 112)
