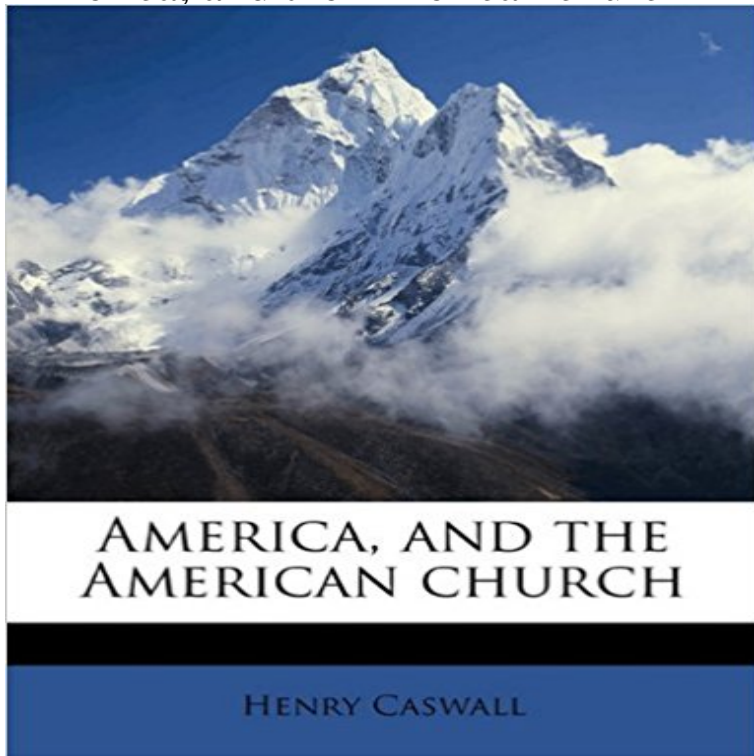


America, and the American church
