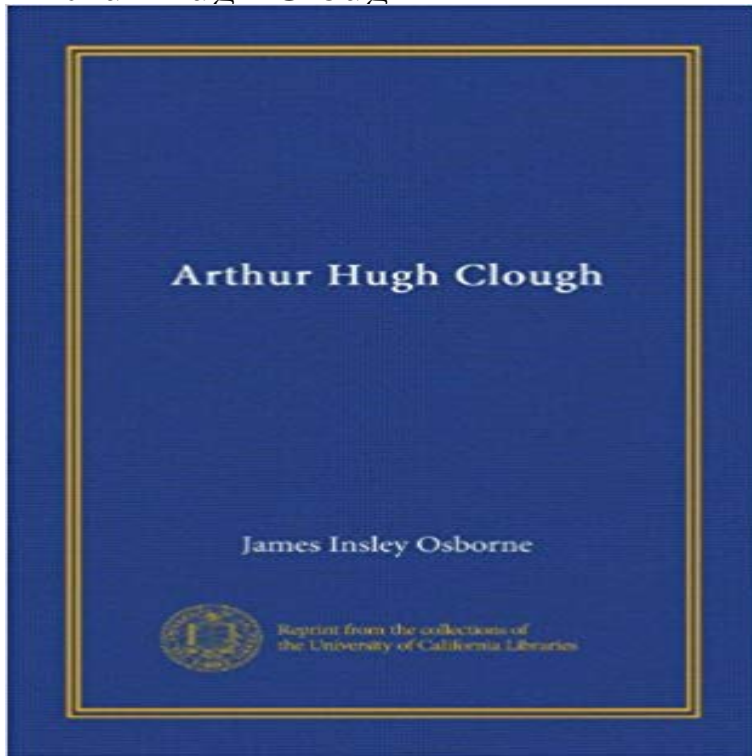


Arthur Hugh Clough
