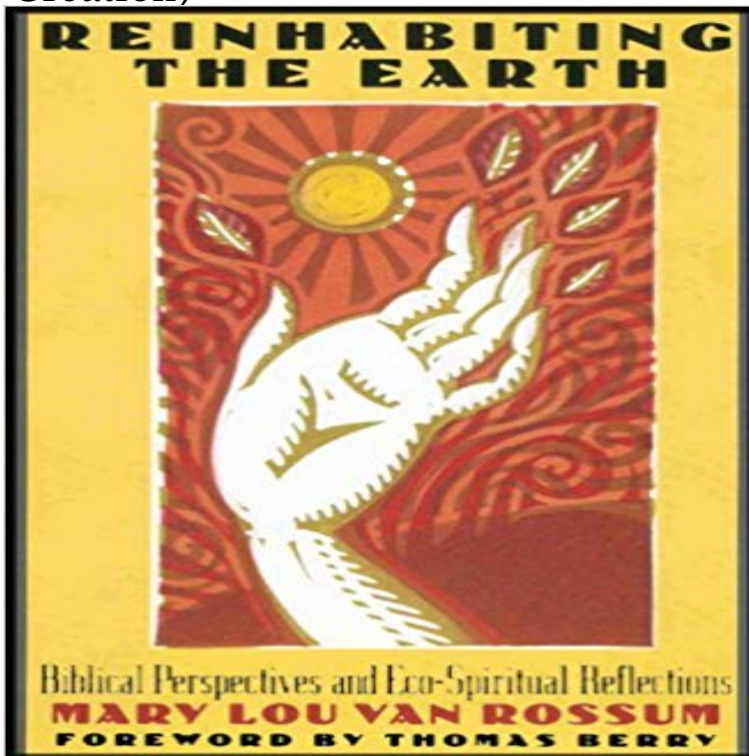


# Reinhabiting the Earth - Biblical Perspectives and Eco-spiritual Reflections (A Call to Compassionate Living in the Community of Creation)
