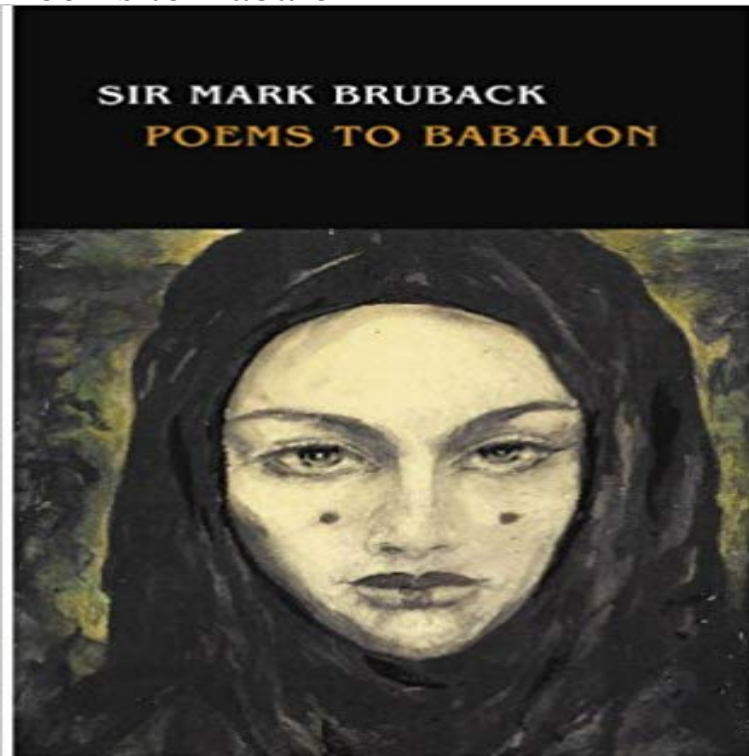


Poems to Babalon
