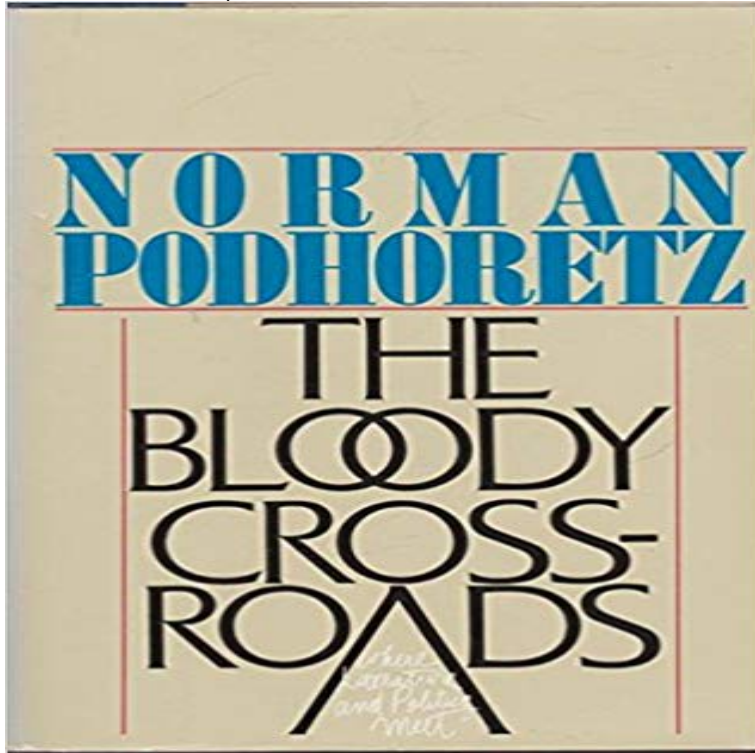


The Bloody Crossroads: Where Literature and Politics Meet
