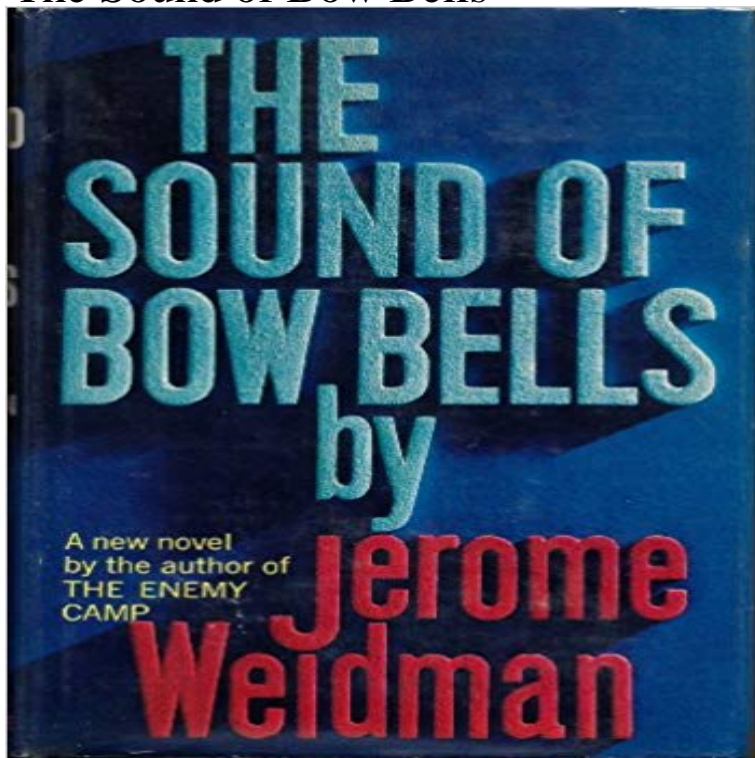


The Sound of Bow Bells
