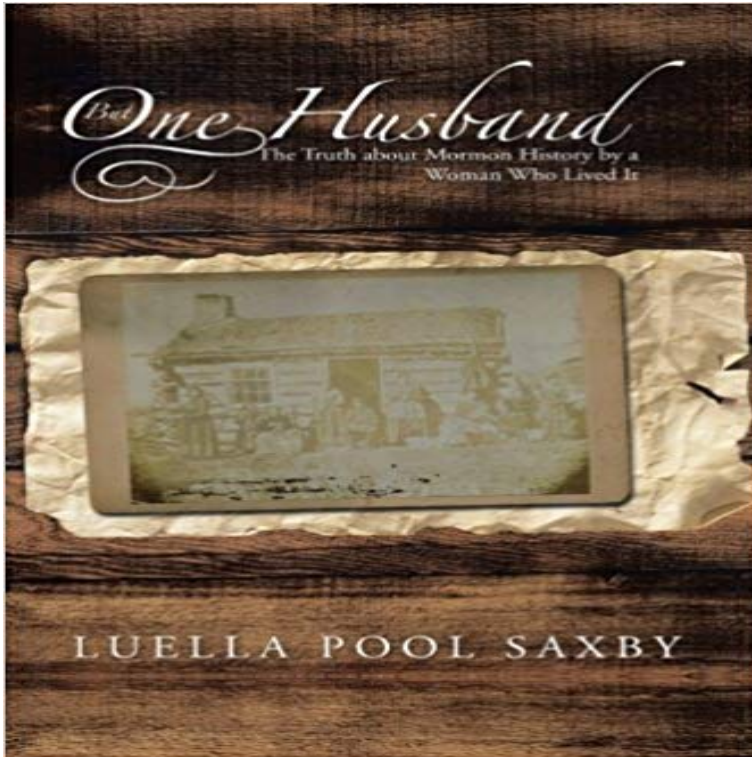


But One Husband: The Truth about Mormon History by a Woman Who Lived It
