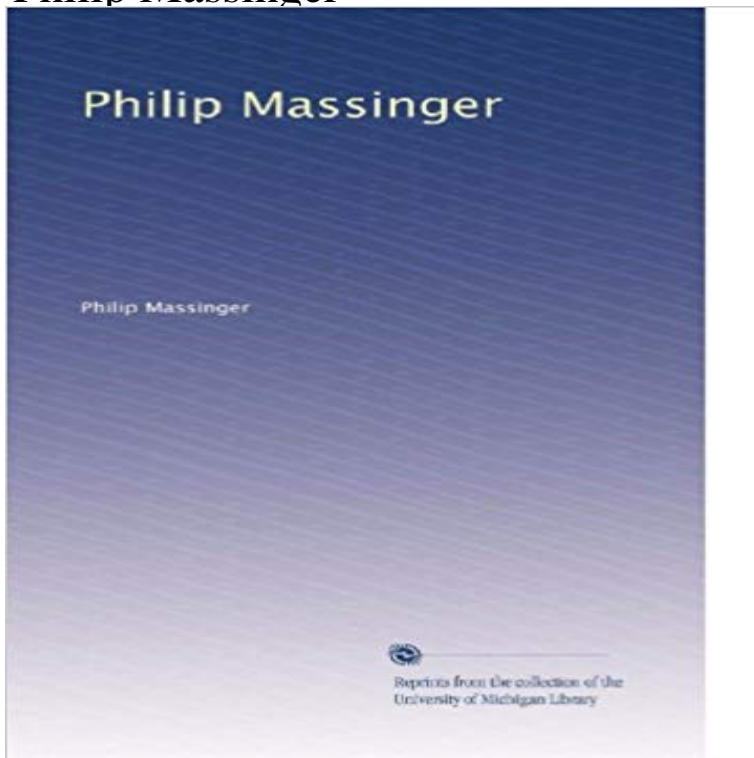


## Philip Massinger
