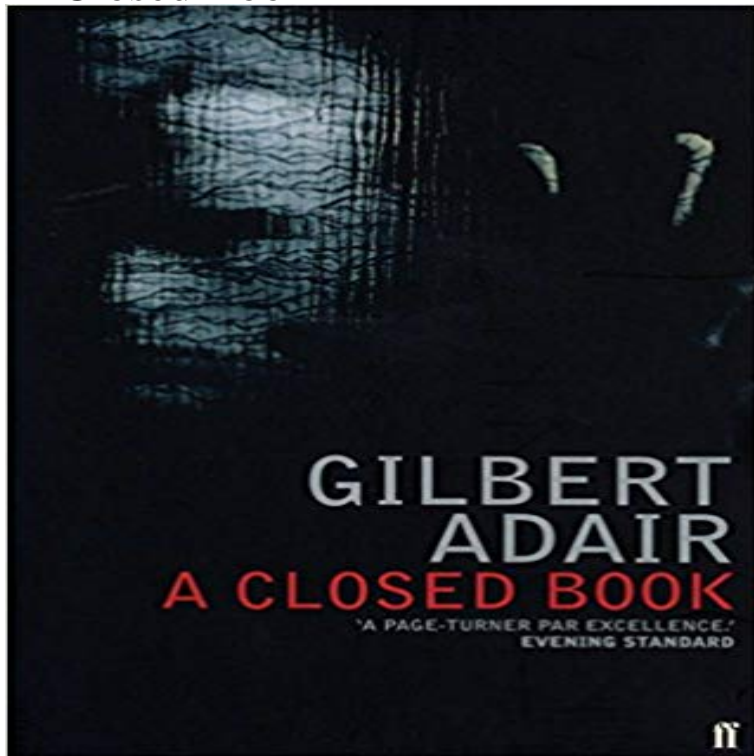


A Closed Book
