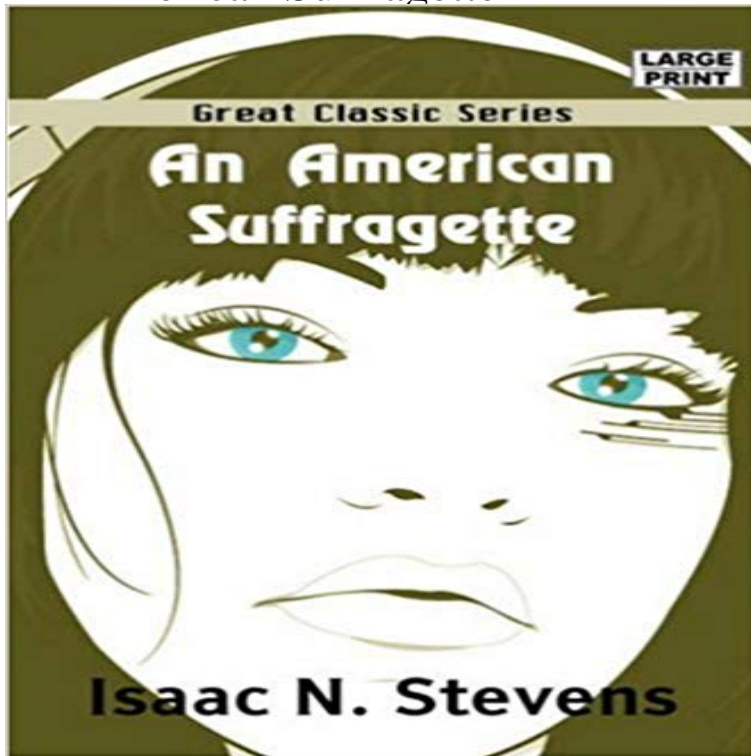


An American Suffragette
