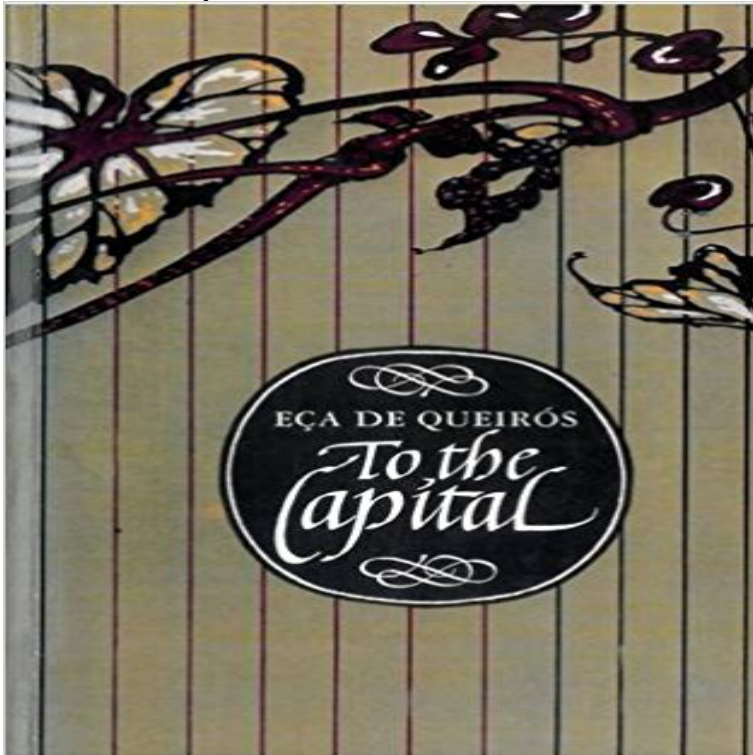


To the Capital
