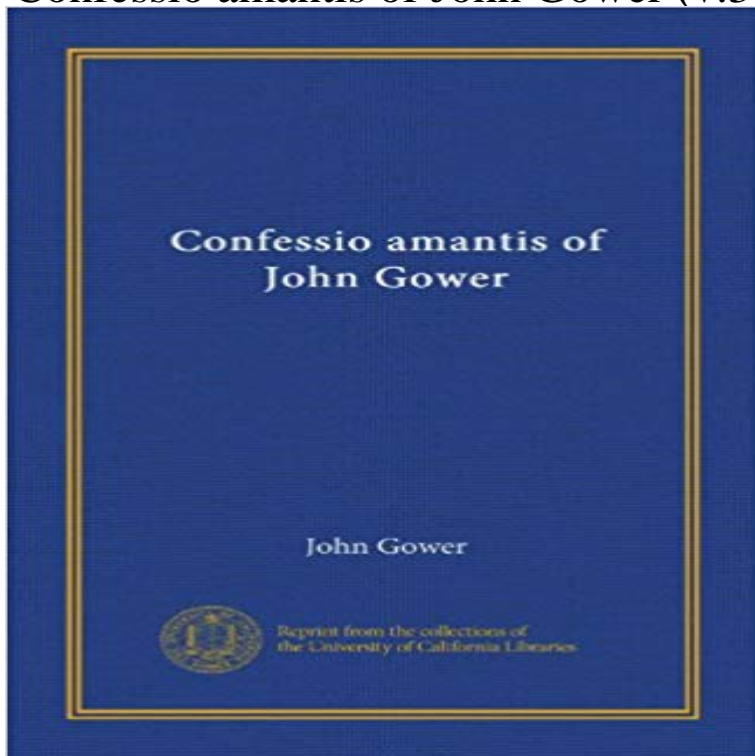


Confessio amantis of John Gower (v.3)
