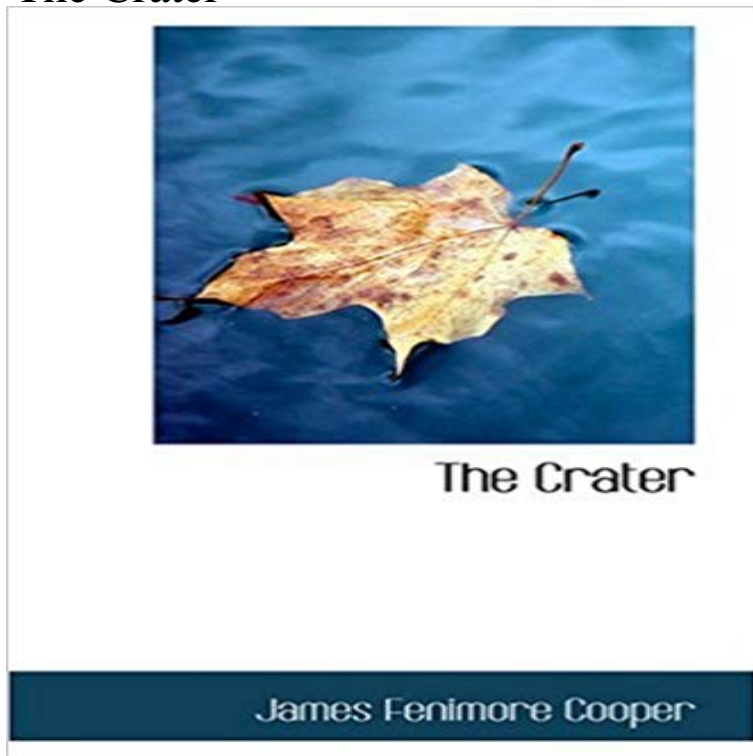


The Crater
