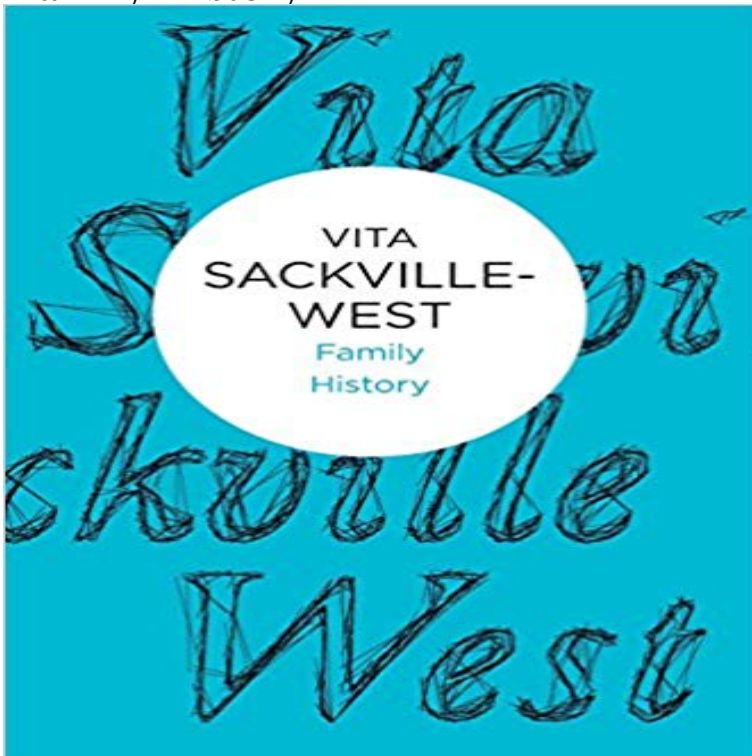


Family History
