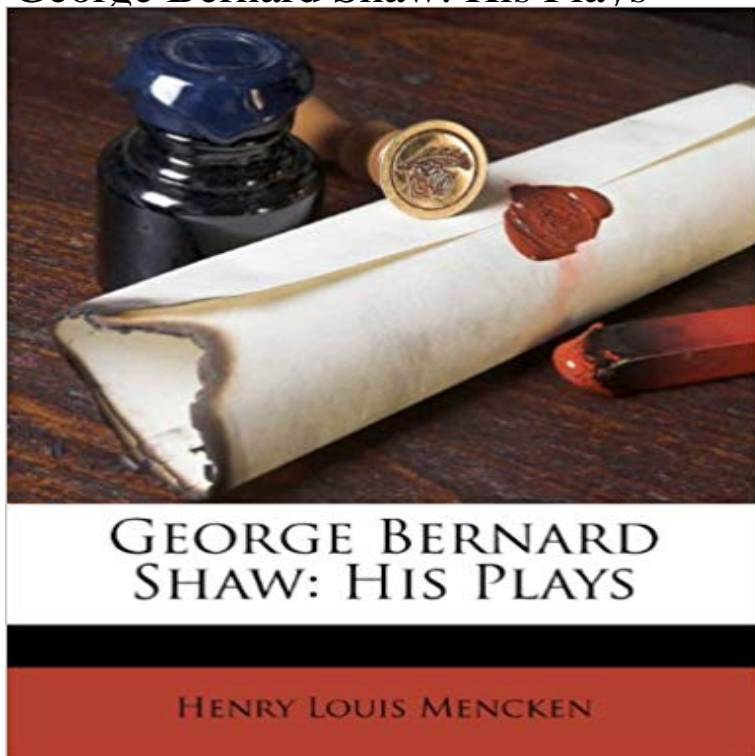


George Bernard Shaw: His Plays
