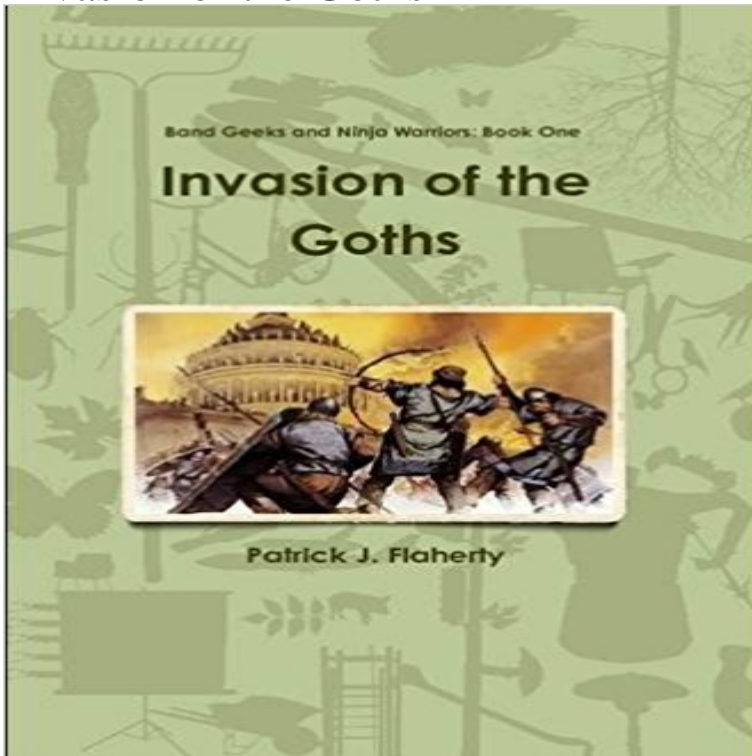


Invasion of the Goths
