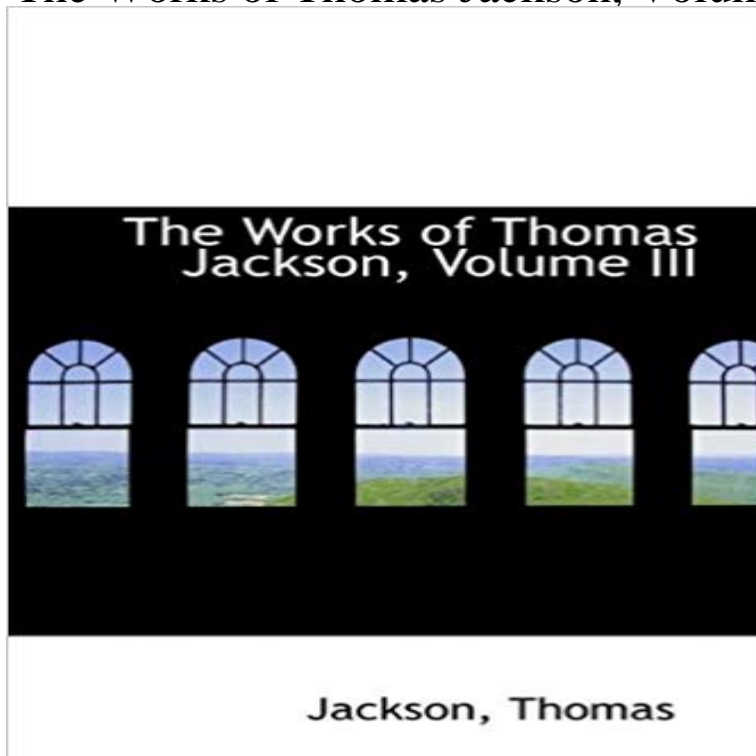


The Works of Thomas Jackson, Volume III
