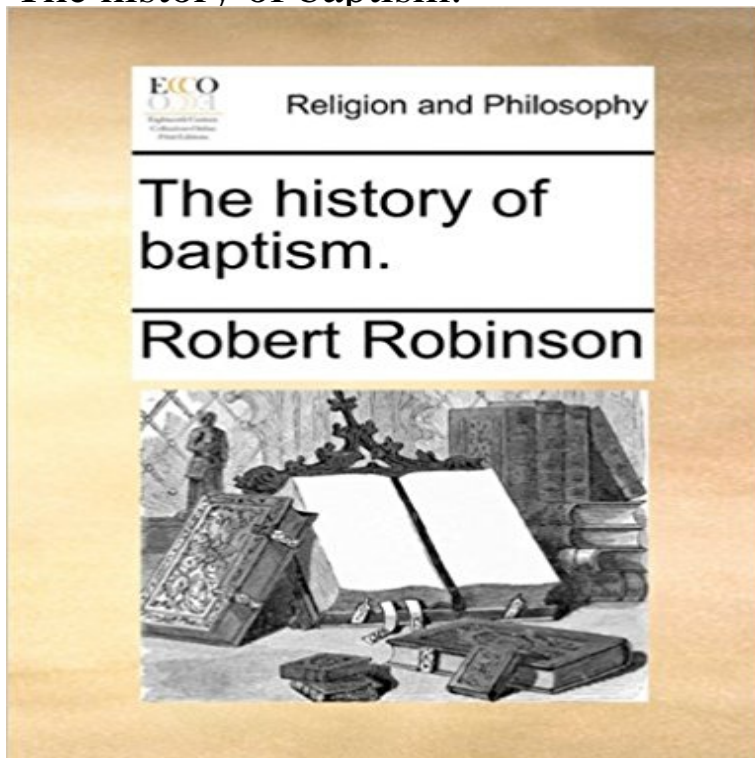


The history of baptism.
