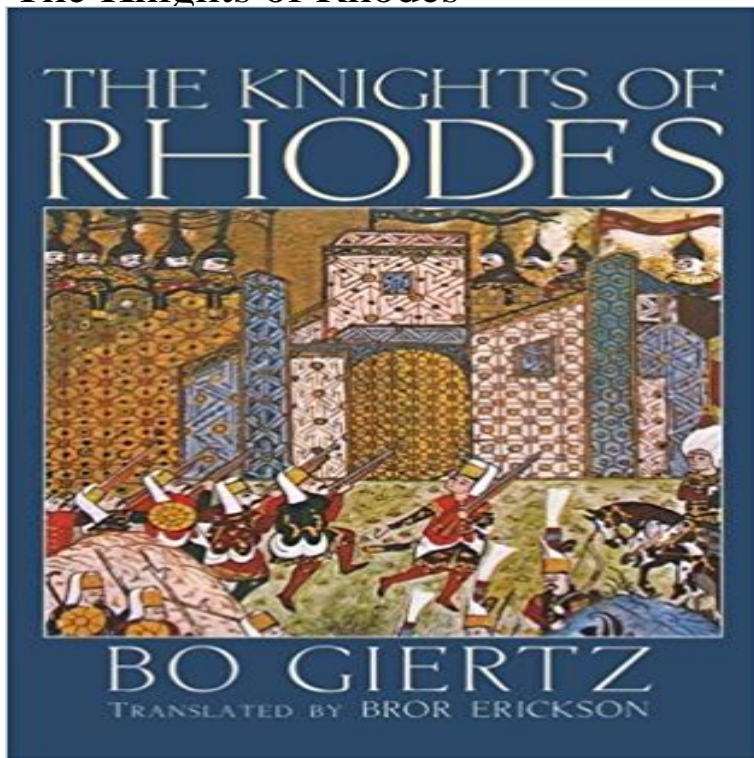


The Knights of Rhodes
