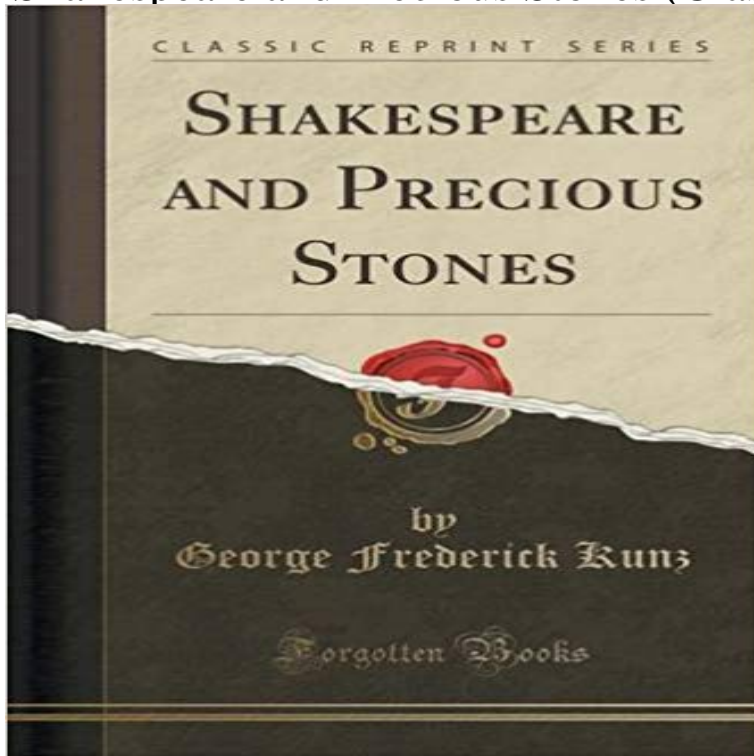


Shakespeare and Precious Stones (Classic Reprint)
