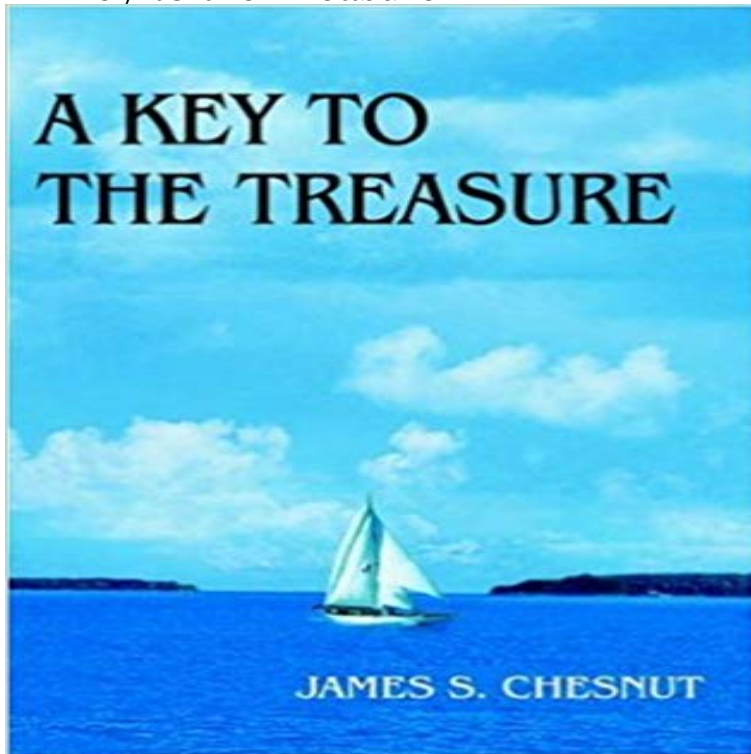


A Key to the Treasure
