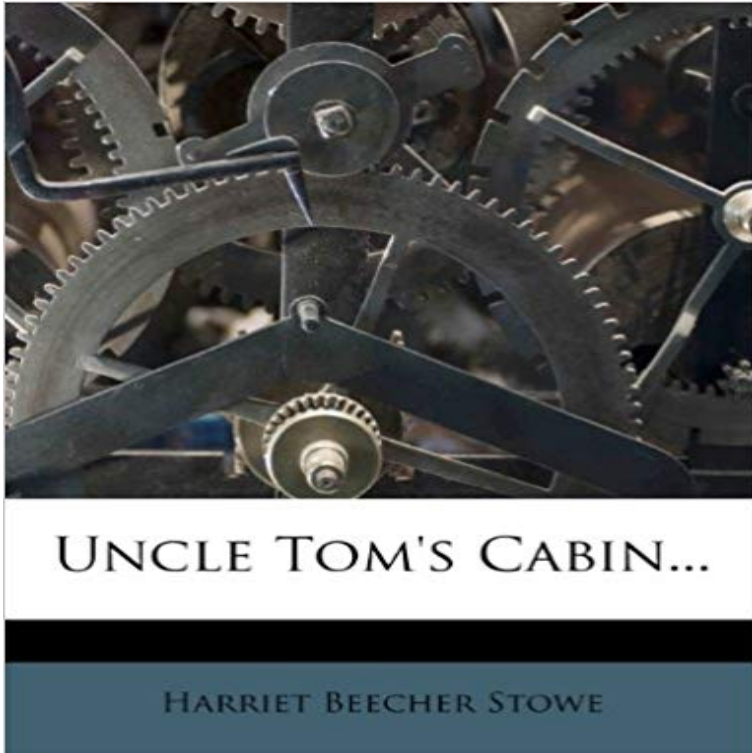


## Uncle Toms Cabin...
