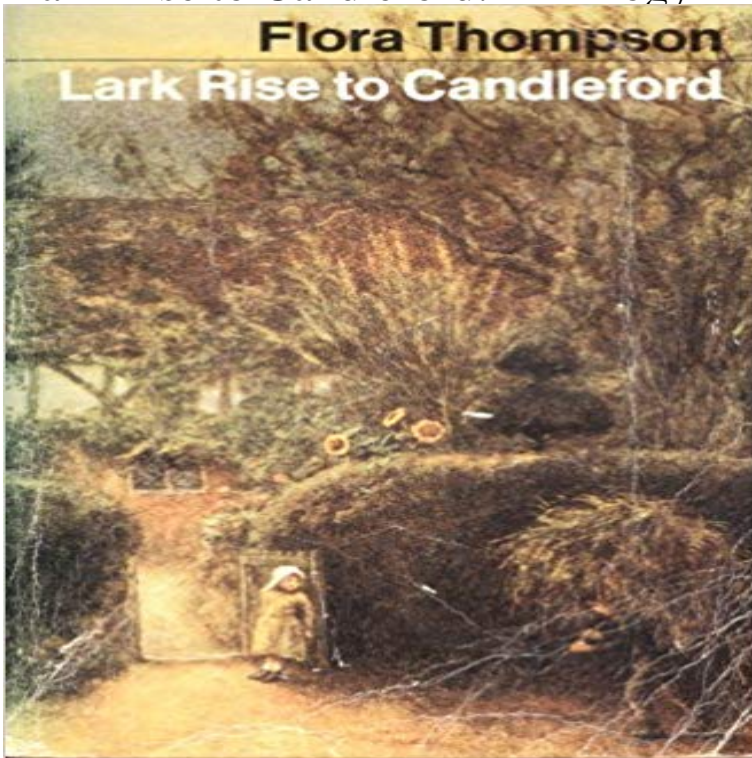


## Lark Rise to Candleford: A Trilogy
