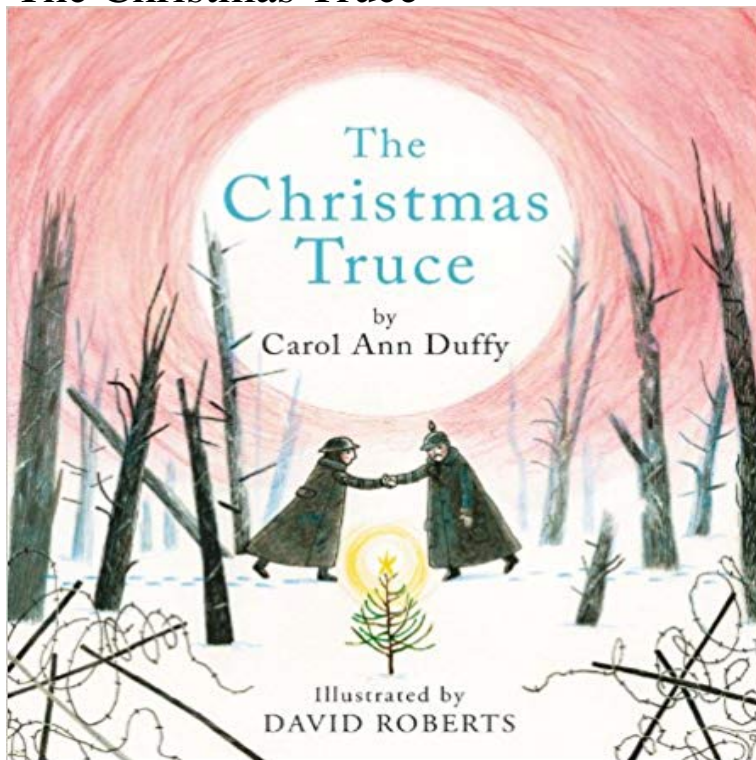


The Christmas Truce
