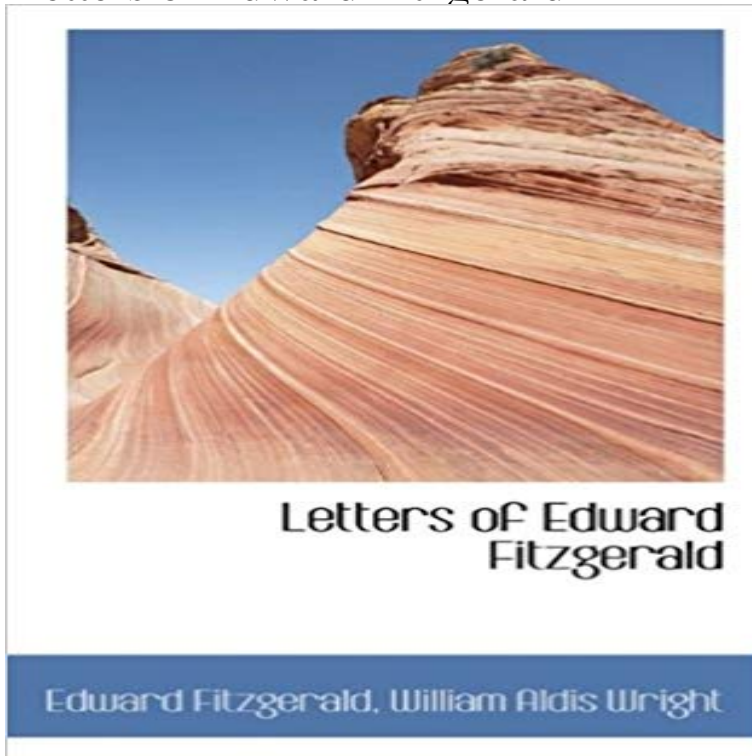


Letters of Edward Fitzgerald
