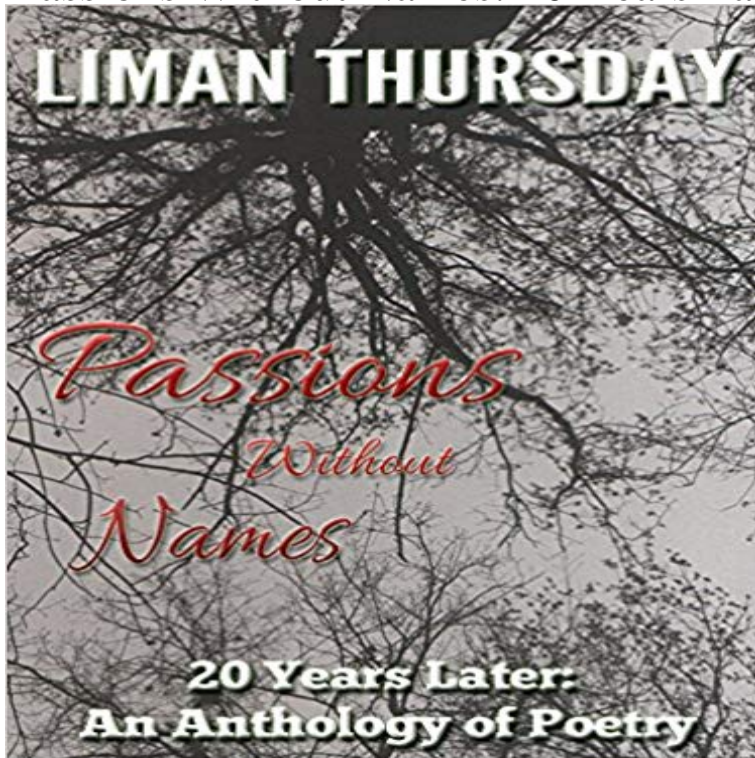


Passions Without Names: 20 Years Later: An Anthology of Poetry
