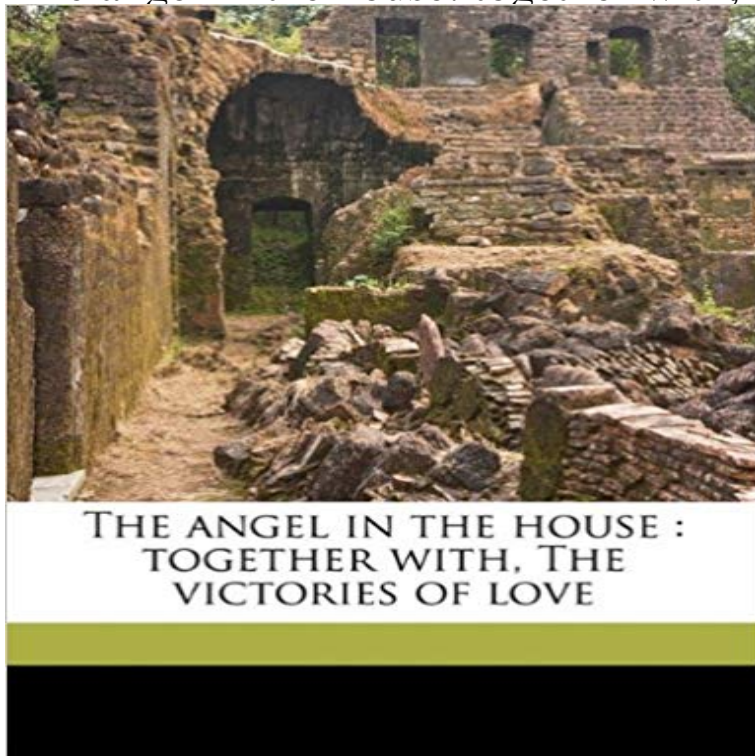


The angel in the house: together with, The victories of love
