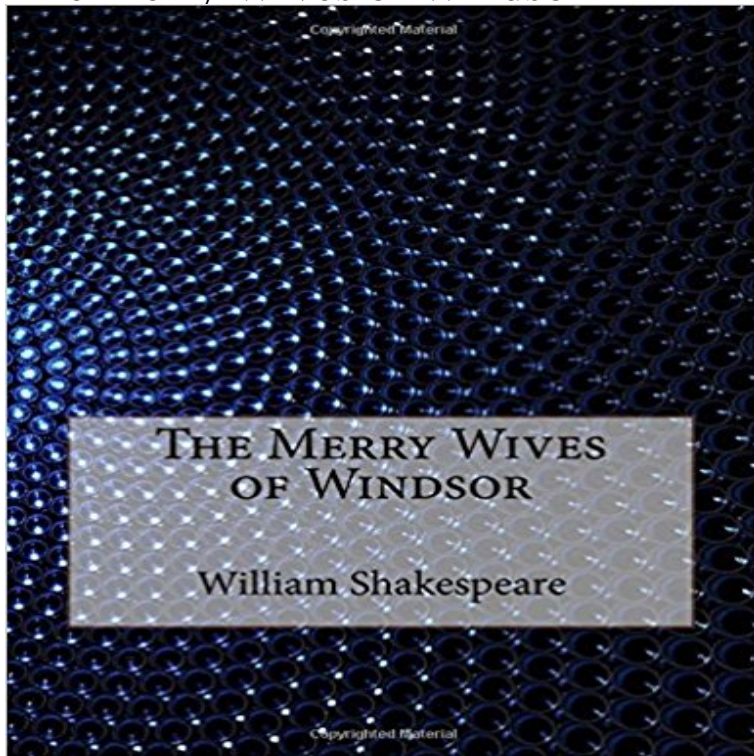


The Merry Wives of Windsor
