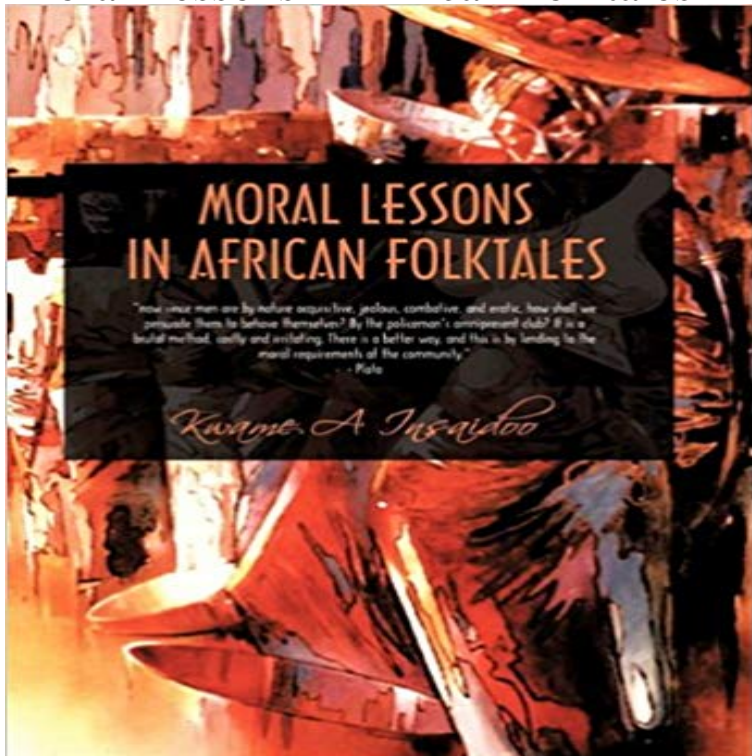


Moral Lessons in African Folktales

Throughout this book the author emphasizes the significance of proper moral education in shaping the character of children, youngsters and even adults, and reminds us: morals are the rules by which society exhorts its members and associations to behavior consistent with its order, security and growth (Will & Ariel Durant).
