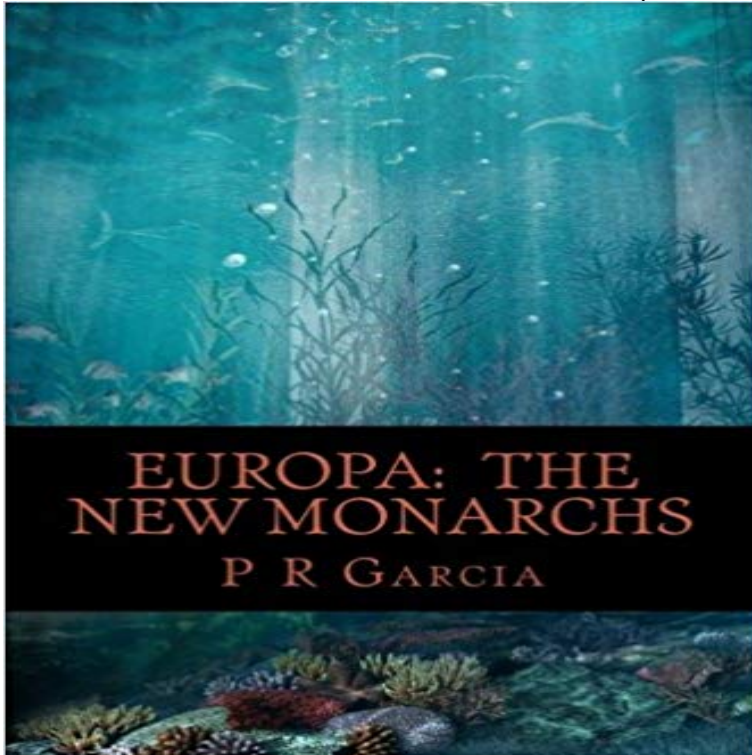


EUROPA: The New Monarchs (Volume 4)
