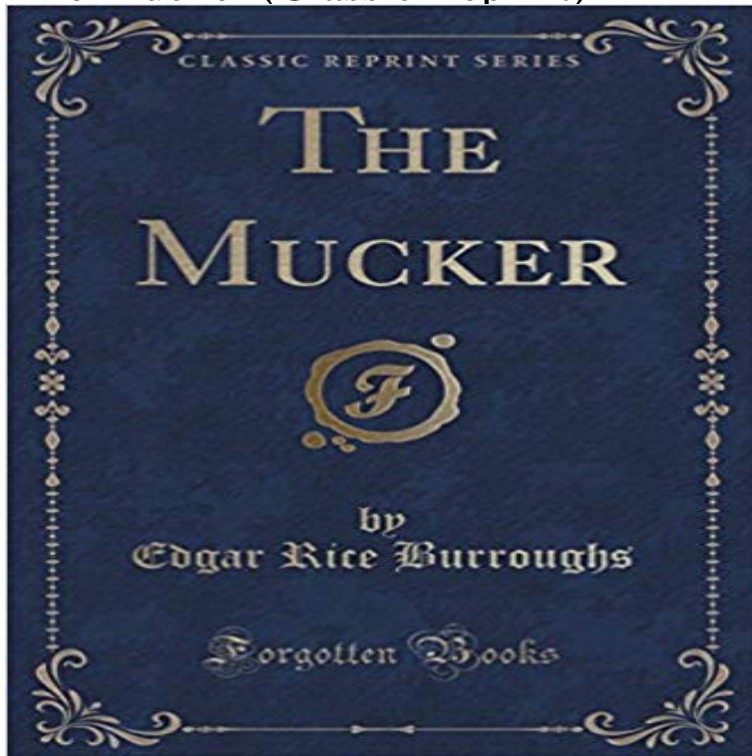


The Mucker (Classic Reprint)
