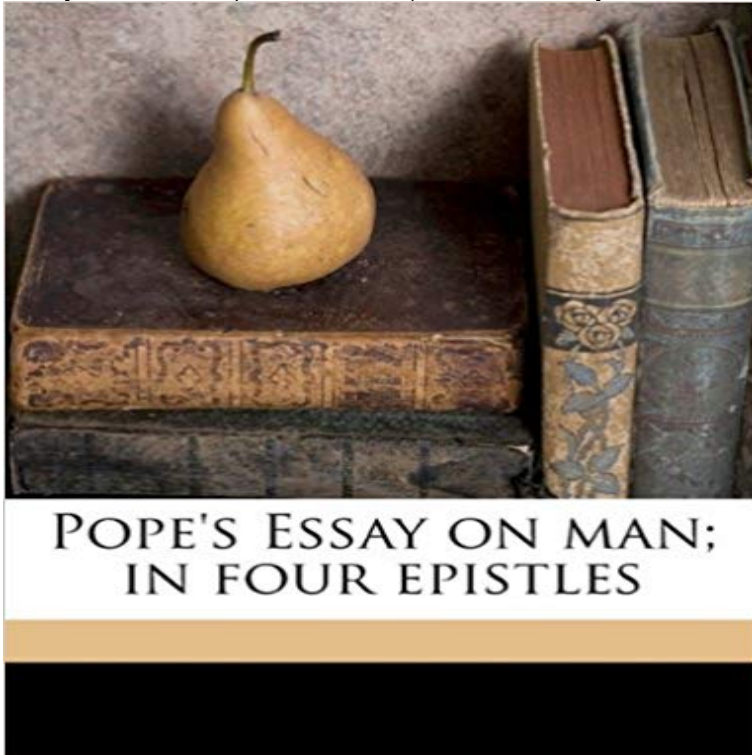


## Popes Essay on man; in four epistles
