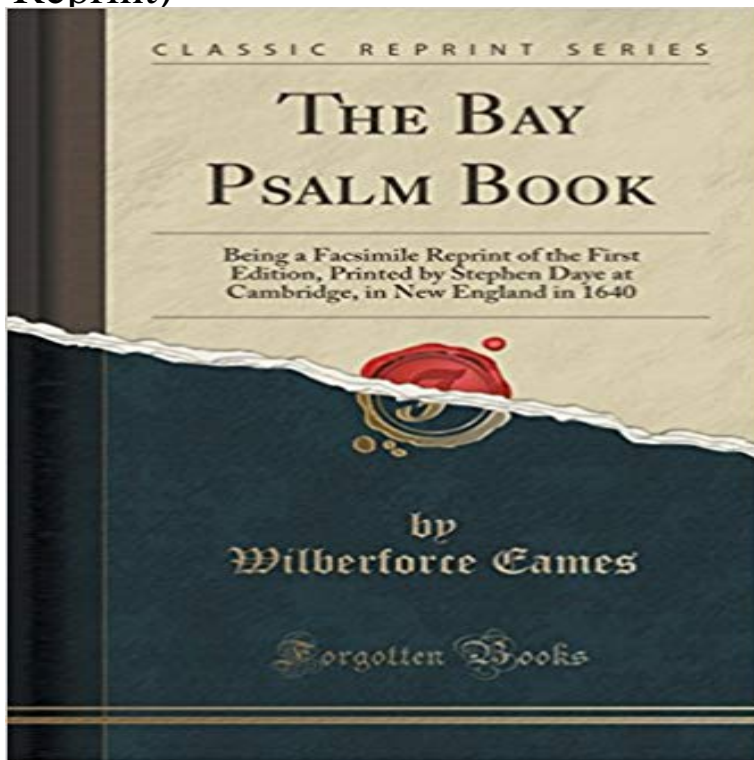

In Plymouth Colony the use of Ainsworth was continued as before until 1692, when the church there also agreed to sing the psalms now used in our neighbor churches in the Bay.
