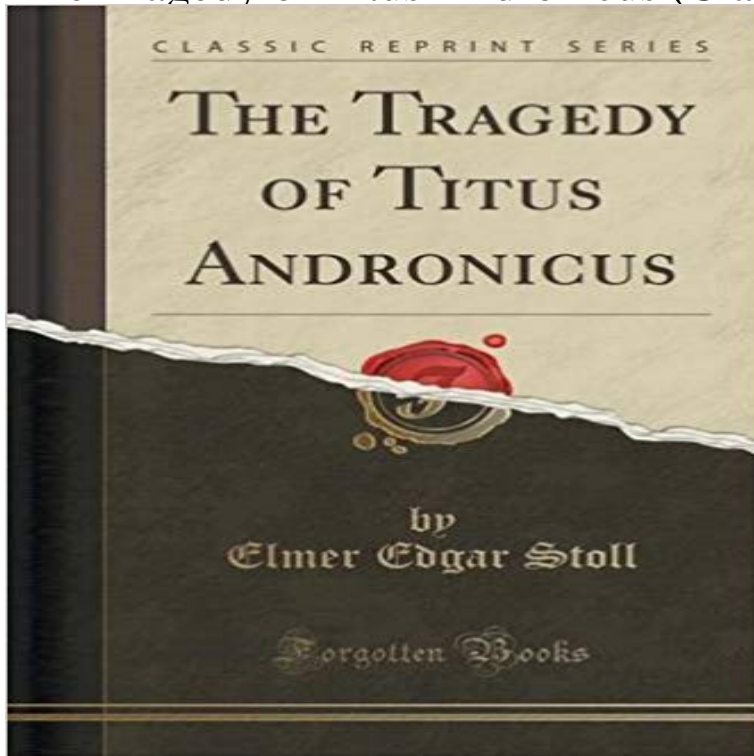


The Tragedy of Titus Andronicus (Classic Reprint)



Excerpt from The Tragedy of Titus AndronicusText. - Under date of January 23, 1594, Henslowe makes note in his diary of a new play, titus ondronicus, performed by the servants of the Earl of Sussex. On February 6 of the same year there is entered to John Danter in the Stationers Register a book entitled A Noble Roman Historye of Tytus Andronicus. An edition published in 1594 was mentioned by Gerard Langbaine in his Account of English Dramatic Poets, in 1691, and a copy of it was at last discovered at Malmo, Sweden, in 1905. It bears the title: The most Lamentable Romaine Tragedie of Titus Andronicus: as it was Plaide by the Right Honorable the Earle of Darbie, Earle of Pembroke and Earle of Sussex their Servants, London. Printed by John Danter, etc., 1594.The Second Quarto(1600) gives a like account of itself on the title-page except for the name of another company still, the Lord Chamberlains, and the name of another printer. Though the changes in this text are on the whole few and slight, there are two omissions, one of six lines in the first scene of the play and another of five lines in the last. From the Second Quarto a third was printed in 1611, and from this, but for the addition of a scene in the third act, was printed the First Folio.
