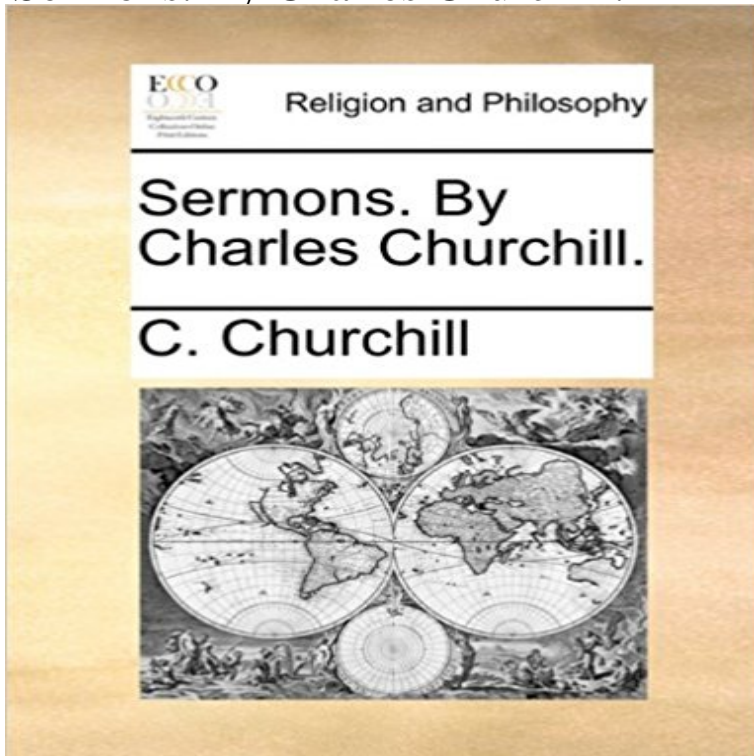


## Sermons. By Charles Churchill.
