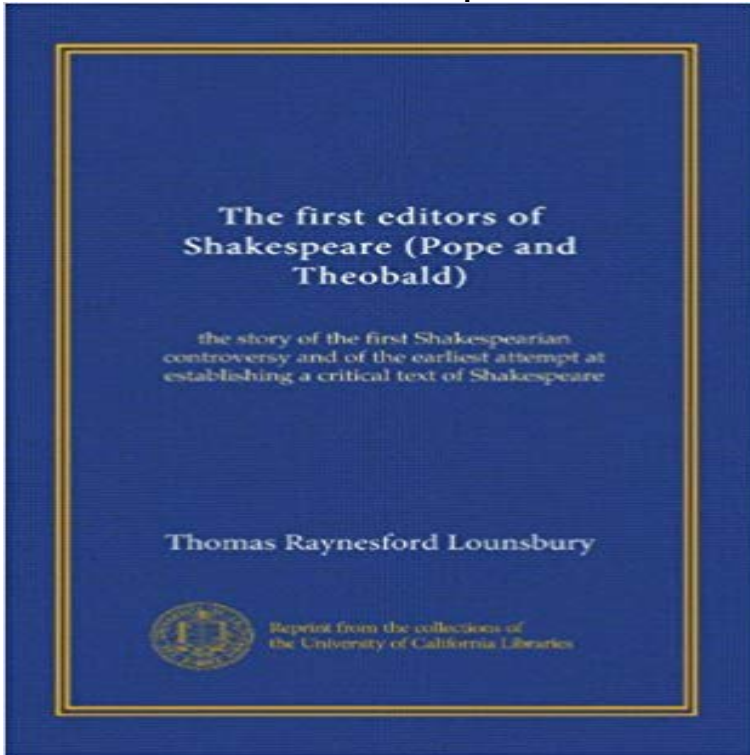


The first editors of Shakespeare (Pope and Theobald): the story of the first Shakespearian controversy and of the earliest attempt at establishing a critical text of Shakespeare
