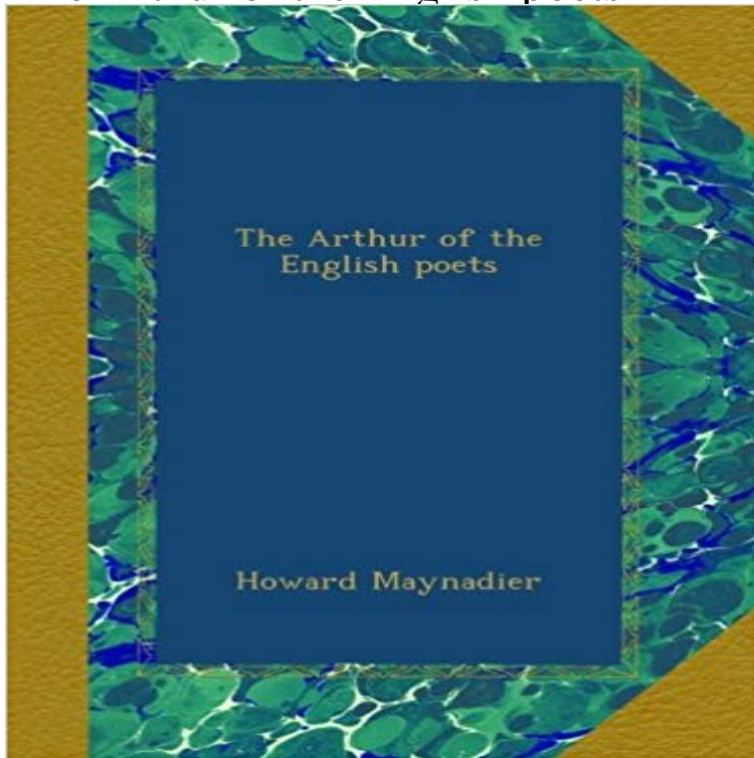


The Arthur of the English poets
