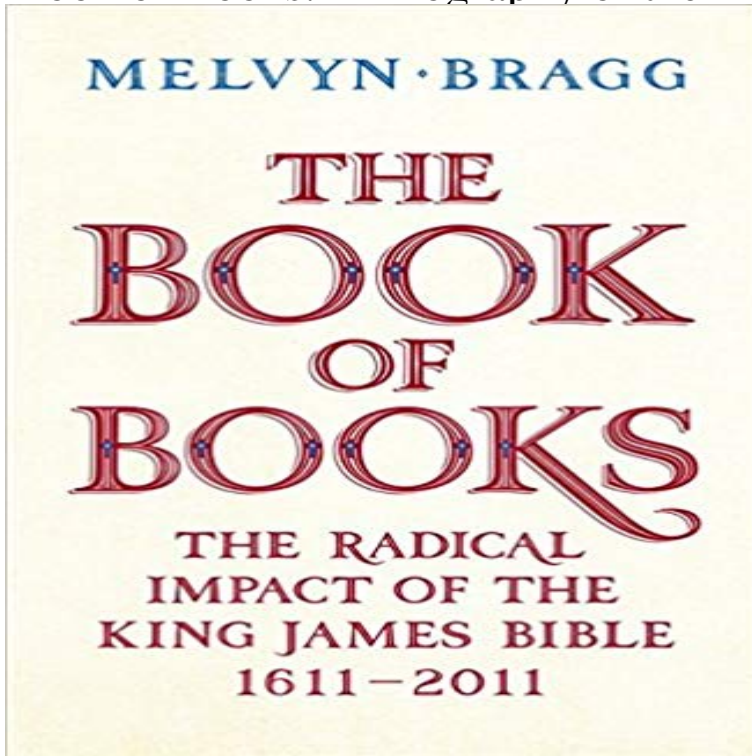


Book of Books: A Biography of the King James Bible, 1611-2011
