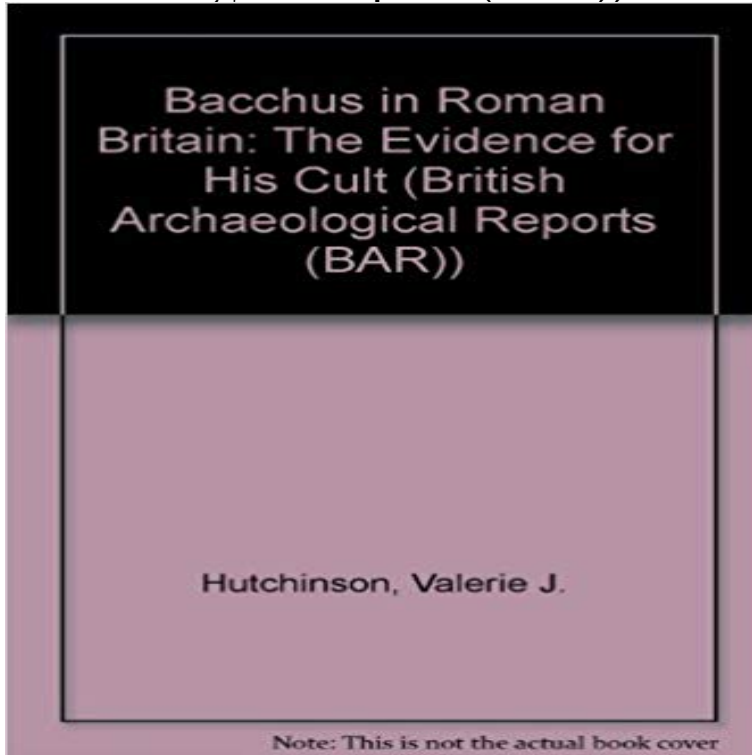


## Bacchus in Roman Britain: The Evidence for his Cult (British Archaeological Reports (BAR))
