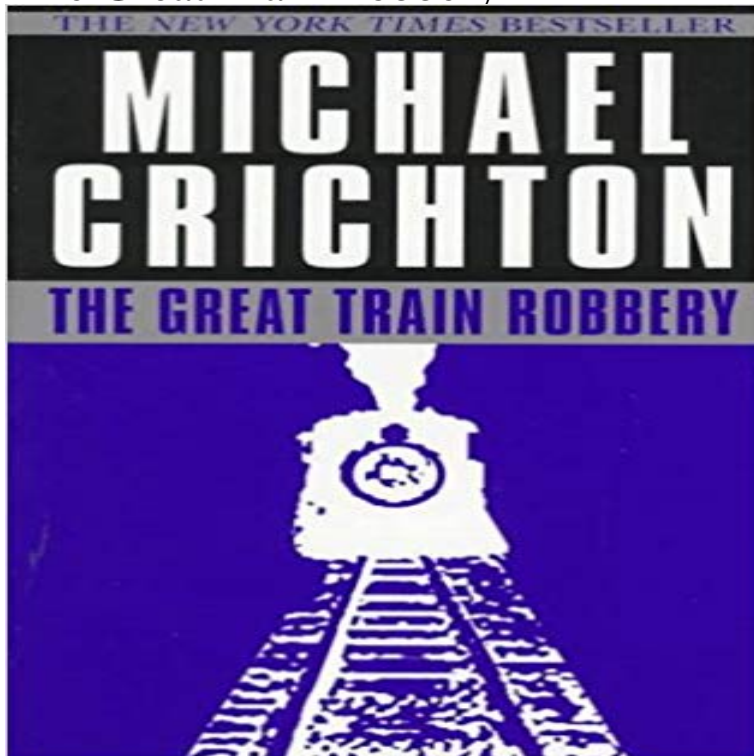


## The Great Train Robbery
