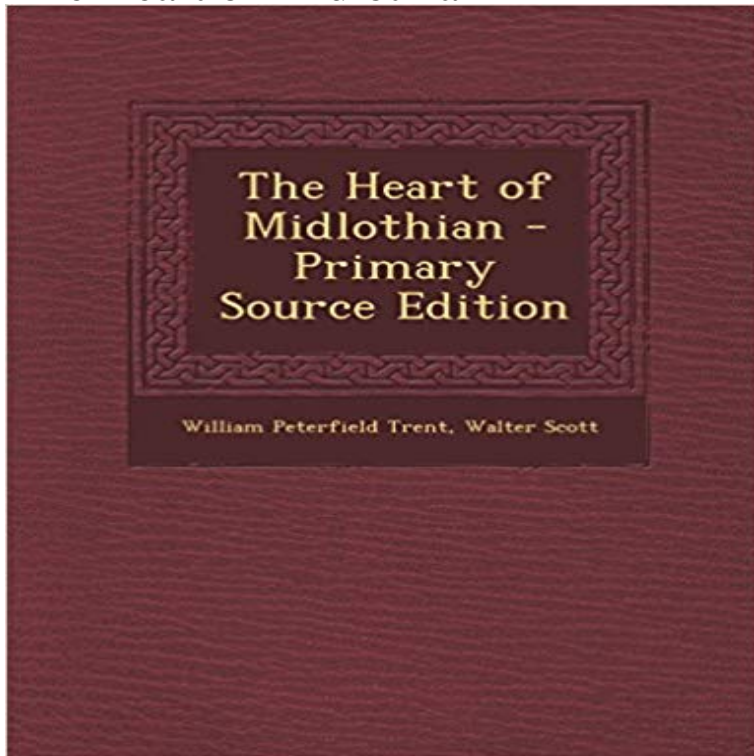


## The Heart of Midlothian
