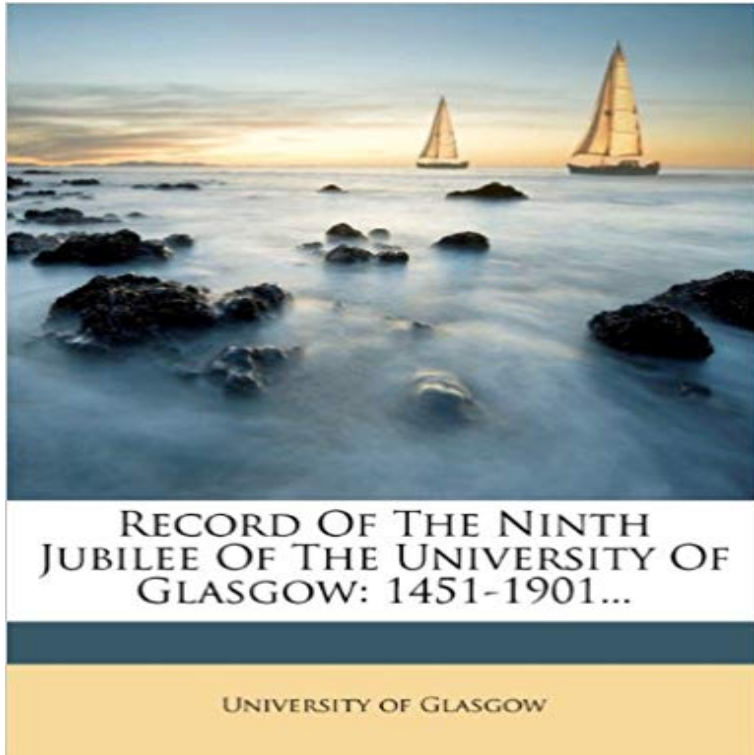


# Record Of The Ninth Jubilee Of The University Of Glasgow: 1451-1901...
