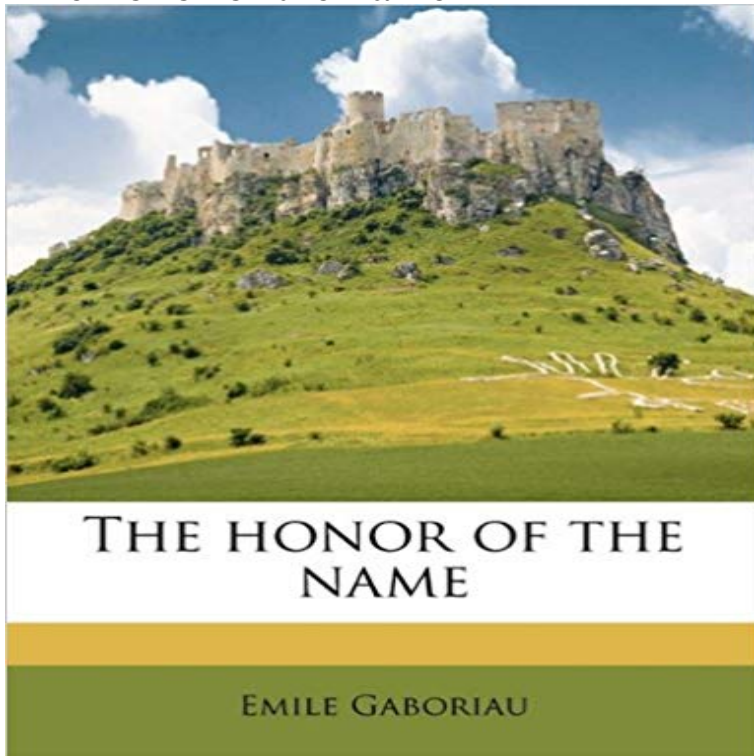


The honor of the name
