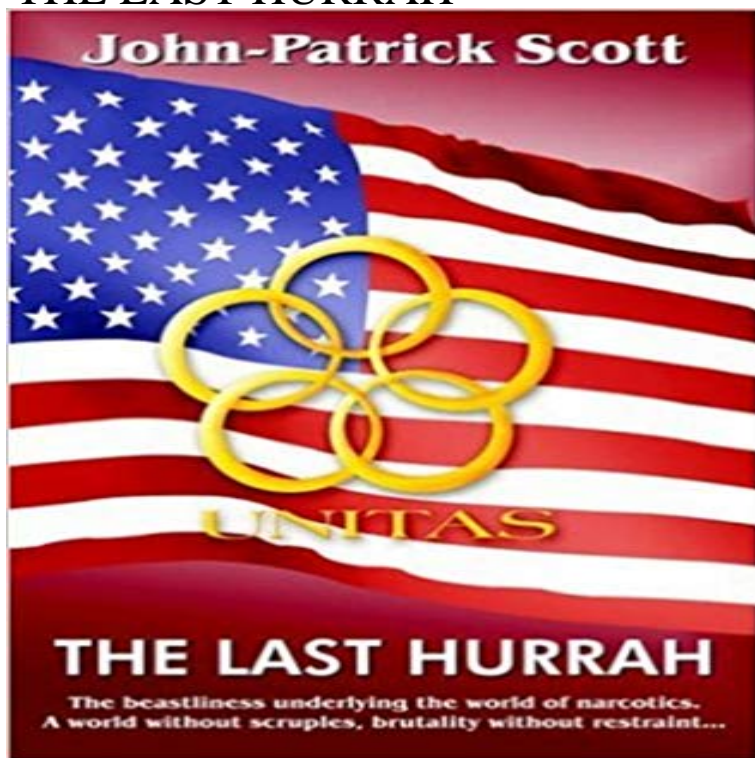


THE LAST HURRAH
