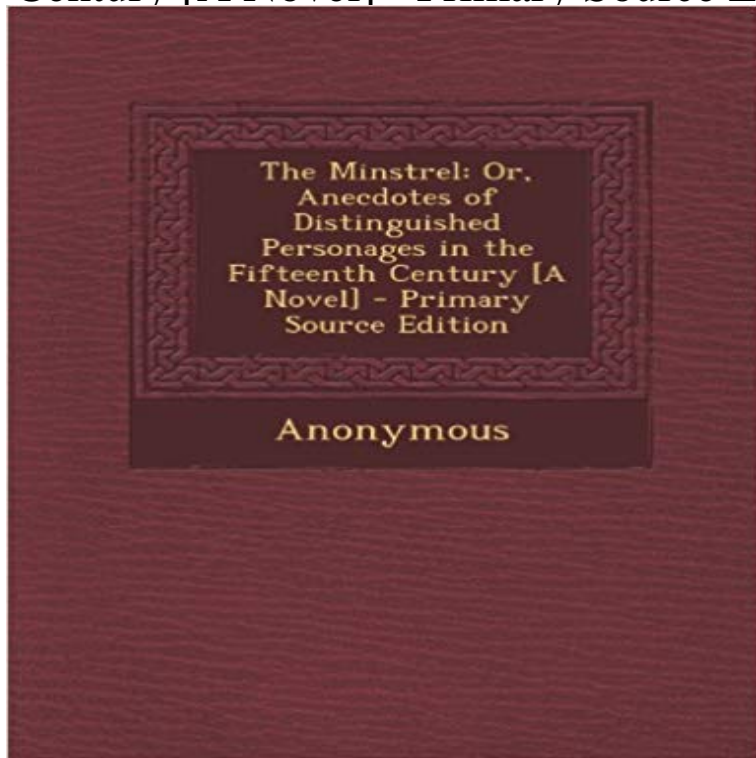


# The Minstrel: Or, Anecdotes of Distinguished Personages in the Fifteenth Century [A Novel] - Primary Source Edition
