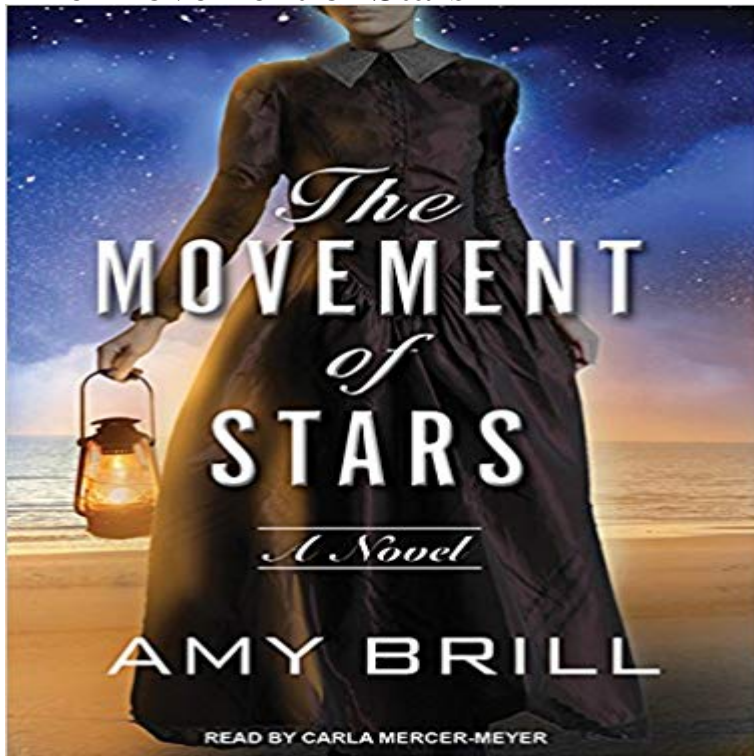


The Movement of Stars

Inspired by the work of Maria Mitchell, the first professional female astronomer in America, *The Movement of Stars* is a richly drawn portrait of desire and ambition in the face of adversity.
